**SUNDAY**

Old English Sunnandæg  
(pronounced ['sunnandæj],  
meaning "sun's day").

## MONDAY

Old English Mōnandæg  
(pronounced ['mo:nandæg])  
meaning "Moon's day".

Days of the week:

## TUESDAY

Old English *Tīwesdaeg*  
(pronounced ['ti:wezdæg],  
meaning "Tiw's day").

Days of the week:

## WEDNESDAY

Old English Wōdnesdæg  
(pronounced ['wo:dnezdæj])  
meaning the day of the  
Germanic god Wodan.

Days of the week:

## THURSDAY

Old English Þūnresdæg  
(pronounced ['θu:nrezdæg]),  
meaning “Thor’s day”.

Days of the week:

## FRIDAY

Old English Frīgedæg  
(pronounced [ˈfriːjɛdæɟ]),  
meaning the day of the  
Anglo-Saxon goddess Fríge.

Days of the week:

## SATURDAY

The only day of the week to retain its Roman origin in English, named after the Roman god Saturn associated with the Titan Cronus.
